MEN'S & WOMEN'S SOCCER SUPPLEMENT

.00 SOCCER

.01 SEASON LIMITATION: The number of games shall be determined in accordance with COA Rule 9.01.

- A. A two-round schedule of home/away games will be played on Wednesday and Friday of each week.
- B. The starting time for conference games will be 3:15 p.m. on Wednesday and Friday for the first round and 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday and Friday for the second round.
- C. Rain-Out Schedule
 - 1. Any game cancelled due to rain will be played the following Monday.
 - 2. Any Wednesday/Friday combination rain-out games will be played on successive Mondays.
- D. Schedule Changes: Any changes in schedule must be approved by the Conference. All member colleges must be informed of any approved schedule changes.

.02 RULES

- A. FIFA rules will govern league play:
 - 1. Two 45 minute halves.
 - 2. Free substitution.
 - 3. Unlimited number of players on the roster.
 - 4. Playoff games resulting in a tie.
- B. Officials: A minimum of two or maximum of three officials will be assigned for all conference games.
- C. Equipment:
 - 1. Three (3) balls will be provided by the home team for each game.
 - 2. Uniforms: HOME TEAM WILL WEAR DARK JERSEYS.
AWAY TEAM WILL WEAR LIGHT JERSEYS.
- D. Facilities: Home team to provide training room and facility available for visitors. A minimum of three benches will be provided for team. When possible, a 5 yard restraining line is to be used for crowd control.

- E. Protest: If a game is arbitrarily called or a protest is lodged, it must go to the Protest Committee to determine the resolution of the protest.

A game is automatically forfeited if either team:

1. Fails to appear within fifteen (15) minutes of the designated starting time.
2. Exception will be made when the opposing team has been notified of a late arrival at least one hour before game time or when circumstances beyond control such as an accident to prevent arrival time.

- F. Each coach will exchange line-up cards and one to the head official.

.03 AWARDS

- A. Team: Championships
- B. Individual: Player of the Year
- C. All Conference Selections: Twenty-two players will be named to the All Conference Team.

.04 PLAYOFFS OF CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM DETERMINATION

Championship to be determined by the best point record during the conference play (3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie). In case of a tie by points, the following criteria will be used:

MEN

- 1st Criteria: Head to head conference competition.
- 2nd Criteria: In head to head conference competition divide goals for by goals against among the involved teams.
- 3rd Criteria: Goals for divided by goals against for all conference games.
- 4th Criteria: Total goals against.
- 5th Criteria: Total goals for.

WOMEN

- 1st Criteria: Head to head conference competition.
- 2nd Criteria: In head to head conference competition divide goals for by goals against among the involved teams.
- 3rd Criteria: Total goals against.
- 4th Criteria: Goals for divided by goals against for all conference games.
- 5th Criteria: Total goals for.

.05 COMMITTEE

Conference appointed soccer representative:

1. Chair and reside at all meetings. Shall not have a vote.
2. Membership to consist of all soccer coaches who are currently coaching conference teams.

- F. Player Conduct: The coach is responsible for the conduct of his players.

RED AND YELLOW CARDS

2 yellow = red = Disqualification = removal that game and next game. No strike against athlete.

Red Card Ejection for Verbal or Physical Abuse = removal for that contest and next and strike against athlete. Two strikes against athlete gone for year.

Red Card NOT for Verbal or Physical Abuse = no strike against athlete. Removal from that contest and next contest.

REPORTING

Coaches must report CARDS to AD and Conference Commissioner.
